March: ACCREDITATION

From March 25th to 28th, we underwent an intensive 3-day survey with Accreditation Canada in our first attempt to achieve Full Accreditation Status. Over the 3 days, we hosted two surveyors from Accreditation Canada who tested us on every aspect of service delivery in the following categories:

- Home Care Services
- Infection Prevention and Control
- Leadership
- Medication Management
- Service Excellence

At the end of the 3 days, the surveyors compiled their report and submitted it to Accreditation Canada's "Decision Committee" for review. The review took approximately 4 weeks to complete at the end of which we were awarded full Accreditation Status with "Exemplary" Status!

What does this mean?

There are 3 possible ratings to be awarded in a successful Accreditation Survey:

- 1. Accredited
- 2. Accredited with Commendation
- 3. Accredited with "Exemplary" Status

This means that after 3 years of hard work and determination, we have proudly achieved the highest possible rating for Accreditation! This is a tremendous accomplishment for a small agency and we are so proud and grateful to all our clients and staff for your support and participation throughout this 3-year process.

So what happens next?

Now that we're accredited, it's important for us to maintain the same high level of quality & safety that we've already established. To ensure we stay on track, we will undergo a complete assessment by Accreditation Canada once every 4 years.

We look forward to working with you over the next 4 years to maintain and improve our processes to ensure that everyone involved in Exploits Homecare (clients, staff, partners) have the best experience possible with our agency.

April/May: Training

On April 18th, we launched our first training opportunity for 2024. All Home Support Workers were invited to participate in an on-line Practical Training course offered through our Website's Employee Portal.

The course offered 7 major components of practical training:

- 1. One-Person Transfer from Bed to Wheelchair and Wheelchair to Bed
- 2. How to Assist Someone with Getting a Shower
- 3. How to Give a Bed Bath
- 4. Helping Someone Up After a Fall

- 5. Donning & Doffing PPE
- 6. Proper Hand Hygiene Techniques
- 7. Five Keys to Safer Food

Fifty-two Home Support Workers participated in the training for a total participation rate of 35%! We are so proud of our Home Support Workers for taking such an interest and pride in the quality of their services to our clients.
